



### Overview

This guide outlines the play rotation for **OMG's open play** that takes place at the Plummer Family Park. This guide can be found on the [OMG Pickleball Club website](#), under the *Learning & New Player* menu in the *Quick Reference Guide* section.

### Rules Based on Number of Players

- When there are **2 to 10 people** waiting to play on a particular skill level court or courts, the losers will leave the court. Anyone who has played two games in a row (the winners) will also leave. Otherwise, the winners will stay.
- When there are **11 or more people** waiting to play on a particular skill level court or courts, all four players will come out after the game, and four new players will go in.

### How Paddles Will Be Stacked

- The paddles will be lined up on the aisleway floor against the court fence with the paddle handle up (see photo below).



- There will be two lines of paddles located in the center of **each set of the skill level courts**.
- The line up on the right (as you face the court) is where the winners will place their paddles when they come off the court. Place the paddle on the left end.
- The line up on the left (as you face the court) is where the people who lost will place their paddles when they come off the court. Place the paddle on the left end.
- Any new player will place his/her paddle at the left end of the shortest paddle line.
- When a particular skill level court opens up, paddles are taken first from the right side.
- Then when another same skill level court opens up, the paddles are taken from the left side.
- This process occurs back and forth.
- Use something to indicate which set of paddles (paddles that won; paddles that lost) is next in.
- The table below summarizes the court assignments by skill level.

Court Number	Skill Level
1 & 2	2.0 - 2.5
3, 4, 5 & 6	3.0 - mid 3.5
7 & 8	High 3.5 - 4.0+
